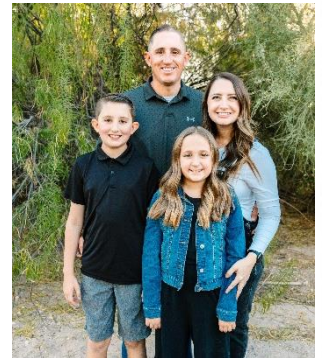


Welcome to 5th Grade!

Supply list
