Mrs. Hodnett's Second Grade Suggested Supply List

Please write your child's name on the following items:

- * **1 half-inch plastic front view** heavy-duty or durable 3-ring binder with pockets on the inside - (Please write name on **inside upper left-hand corner**)
- * 3 wide-ruled spiral notebooks (the thin ones)
- * 3 composition notebooks (full pages of lines)
- * 1 pencil box (***Please no personal pencil sharpeners***)

These items do not need to be labeled with your child's name:

- * 1 pair of earbuds *with case* OR headphones
- * 1 box of Ticonderoga pencils (sharpened please)
- * 2 packages of glue sticks (one stick can be in the pencil box)
- * 1 pair of kid scissors (put in pencil box)
- * 1 **blue plastic** folder with pockets and prongs
- * 2 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons (put in pencil box)
- * 1 package of thick dry erase markers
- * 2 packages of thin **black** dry erase markers
- * Lysol/Clorox wipes
- * Paper towel rolls
- * 1 boxes tissue
- * 1 reams of white copy paper
- * 1 box pencil top erasers
