TARDY POLICY UPDATE

Being on time is vital for reducing classroom disruptions and enabling students to fully engage in learning from the start of each lesson. To support our students' success, we are introducing the following policy changes effective April 21, 2025:

PARENTS WILL BE REQUIRED TO SIGN THEIR CHILD(REN) IN IF THEY ARRIVE AFTER THEIR CLASS START TIME. THIS WILL REQUIRE PARENTS TO PARK IN THE PARKING LOT, NOT THE CARPOOL LANES, AND WALK THEIR CHILDREN IN.
