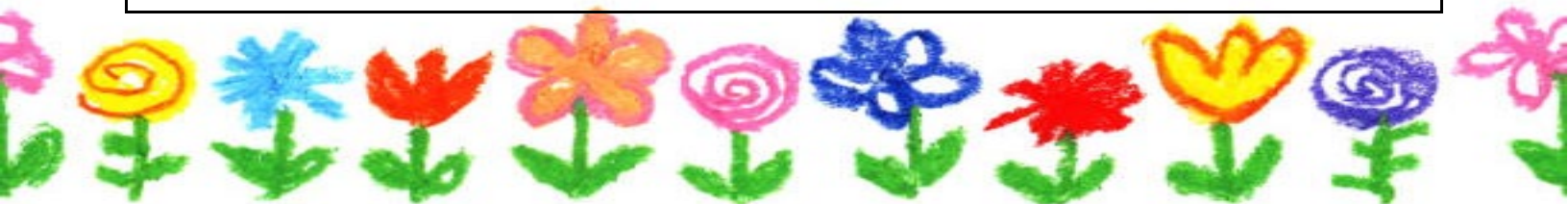

## Items to Bring to Open House

- 1 Spiral-bound notebook (1-subject only, any color)
- 3 Packs crayons (24 count -prefer Crayola brand)
- 1 Package thin Expo markers (black markers work best for our needs)
- 1 Set quality headphones (please make sure headphones are comfortable for your child to wear and place them in a ziplock bag with your child's name on it)
