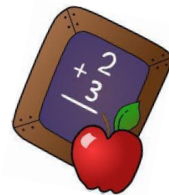


Welcome to Mrs. Moon's Regular Day Kindergarten!

Supply List for Mrs. Moon's Class

Please bring the items listed below to Open House on Thursday, July 17th. Please note, in some instances, I ask for specific name brands. I have learned that some brands just work better than others. Thank you!

- **$\frac{1}{2}$ inch view front binder** (please write your child's name on a piece of paper and put in the view front)
- **BLUE PLASTIC pocket folder that is three hole punched (goes in binder)**
- 5 boxes of 24 count CRAYOLA crayons
- 1 composition notebook (lined paper) (please write your child's name on inside cover)
- 12 Large ELMER'S glue sticks (0.77 oz size)
- Package of baby wipes
- 1 package of pre-sharpened Ticonderoga pencils
- 1 roll of paper towels
- Kleenex
- 1 pack of thick Expo markers (colored)
- 1 pack of thick or thin Expo markers (black)
- Over the ear headphones (to keep at school)

(please put the headphones inside a gallon Ziploc bag and write your child's name on the bag AND on the headphones)

Additional Supplies you will need:

- *backpack (regular sized not preschool sized. No wheels. Should fit their binder easily)
- *waterbottle (labeled with name)
- *lunchbox (or paper bags)

Boys: Clorox/Lysol wipes

Girls: Ziploc bags (gallon or sandwich size)
