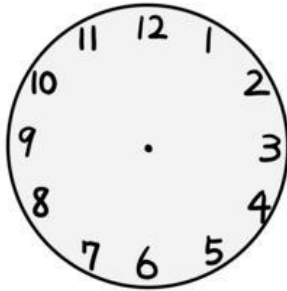
3. Square: Draw a shape with 4 equal sides. What is it?

4. Draw a circle. Split it into 2 equal parts. Color one part.

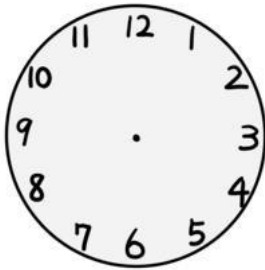


Page 5: Time and Money
