Dear EDUPRIZE Parents,

First-quarter Parent/Teacher Conferences are here, and we are excited to share the news about your child! Conferences for grades K through 6th start next week. For the conference time, our goal is to show you where your child is at right now in relation to grade level standards, show you the plan to meet these standards and to establish the connection needed for a strong year. This home connection provides one of the key ingredients in optimizing academic and emotional growth for students. We thank you for your involvement and appreciate your support. EDUPRIZE teachers will offer specific and thorough feedback during conferences, including baseline assessments to see where students are starting this year. Teachers will be sharing STPs (Student Tailored Prescriptions) that will outline specific goals for your child in the core content areas as well as social-emotional goals. Conferences are a time for the teacher to share, however, it is also a time for you to share suggestions or concerns that you may have--we are a team. In order for this time to run smoothly and effectively, here are a few recommendations:

- Make a list of questions and comments before the conference so you can best utilize the 20 minutes scheduled.
- Let your child's teacher know what he or she loves about this year.
- Be receptive to information the teacher is providing – remember, we are a team and need to work together.
- After the conference, talk with your child and set goals for the year based on the information you have received. Math facts and reading are easy things to implement as goals in the home. 30 minutes a day of a set routine will yield great improvements.
- If you run out of time, please do not continue past the allotted period – you may need to schedule a follow up meeting with your child's teacher.
- Call if you need to reschedule your appointment.
- If you must bring children with you to conferences, keep them with you at all times. Children may not be left unsupervised and the playground is closed during conferences.

Thank you, once again, for allowing us to build a strong home connection. We look forward to seeing you at conferences and setting a wonderful year of growth together.

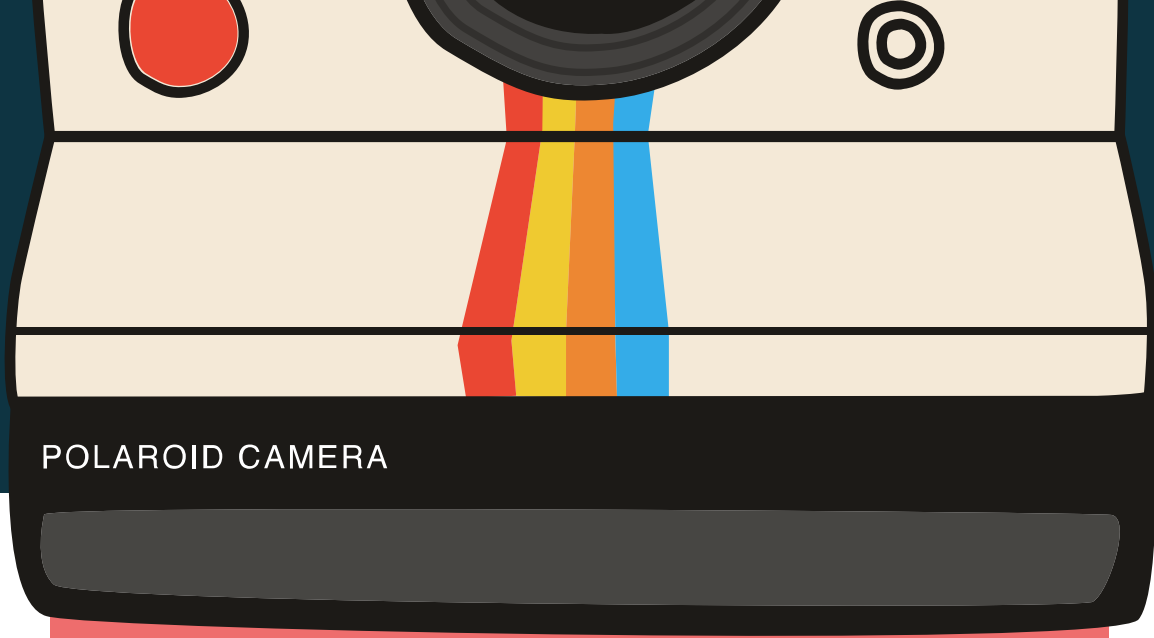
