Student Full Time Enrollment Equivalency Statement

Student and Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

We will share the responsibility to improve student academic achievement and achieve the state's standards. Specifically, the student will:

1. Participate in a minimum of four (4) courses for the entire time of enrollment in EDUPRIZE Online Instruction.
2. Agree to complete the annual number of hours required by their grade level:
 - 9th - 12th grade - 900 hours or more
 - 7th - 8th grade - 1068 hours or more
 - 4th - 6th grade - 890 hours or more
 - 1st - 3rd grade - 712 hours or more
 - KG - 346 hours or more (limited to half day KG)
3. Attend meetings/testing sessions at school, if required.
4. State Assessment Requirements: Pupils who participate in Arizona online instruction are subject to the testing requirements prescribed by the state for grades 3 - 12. (A.R.S. § 15-808-B)
 - Students are required to appear in person to complete state assessments
 - Test will be proctored by an EDUPRIZE Online Instruction instructor
 - "If a pupil fails to comply with the testing requirements and the school administers the tests pursuant to state statutes to less than ninety-five percent of the pupils in Arizona online instruction, the pupil shall not be allowed to participate in Arizona online instruction." (A.R.S. § 15-808-B)
5. EDUPRIZE Online Instruction provides notification of testing dates and locations to parents through parent newsletters, email, and the school messaging system.
