# 6th Grade Students

Arizona Department of Health requires 2 vaccinations for ALL 6th grade students.

Your child MUST have these 2 vaccinations in order to stay in school.

You may opt to sign an exemption waiver if needed, otherwise, vaccinations or waiver must be turned in by Friday, October 30<sup>th</sup>.

1. Meningococcal
2. Tdap (Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis)
