- Dress Code:
 - Boys: Must wear swim trunks with shirt. No jean shorts.
 - Girls: Must wear a swimsuit along with shorts and top over swimsuit.
- What to bring?
 - Morning sessions: please come to school dressed in your bathing suit, water shorts, and water shirt. Make sure sunscreen is applied at home, especially for younger grades prior to school arrival. School staff will **not** be able to help apply sunscreen.
 - Afternoon session will need to change into water-day attire later in the day.
 - Towel

 - Water bottle

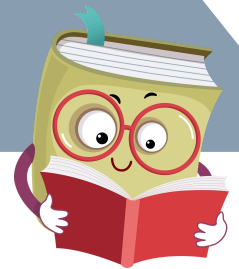
