The following list of suggested supplies will be used throughout the school year. Please bring them to Open House. Thank you for contributing to our classroom.

***** Personal Student Supplies *****

Personal items listed below need to be labeled with your child's name. If an item is left in the package, please write your child's name on the outer packaging.

- * Headphones (Please take headphones out of the package and place in a baggie labeled with your child's name. Also put your child's name directly on the headphones with a permanent marker.) Feel free to use headphones purchased last year if they are in good working condition.
- * 1 plastic pencil box (no larger than 5 inches x 8 inches) **** Please place crayons, 2 pencils, 1 glue stick, scissors, and 1 dry erase marker in the box. ****
- * A pair of kid scissors
- * 2 wide-ruled composition notebooks
- * 1 10-pack of Twistable crayons
- * 12 sharpened pencils (Ticonderoga brand preferred-leave in package)
- * 2 (4-pack) of black skinny Expo dry erase markers (keep in package to prevent from drying out)
- * 1 (4-pack) of glue sticks (if you can send in an 8 pack, even better as we go through these so fast) (keep in package to prevent from drying out)
- * 10 sheet protectors
- * 2 black Flair Pens (keep in package to prevent from drying out)

- * 4 plastic folders: 3 prongs. It is important that these folders have prongs, because sheet protectors organized by me will go inside. **Please have the child's name and label on the front of each folder. See below how to label each colored folder:**
