COTTAGE





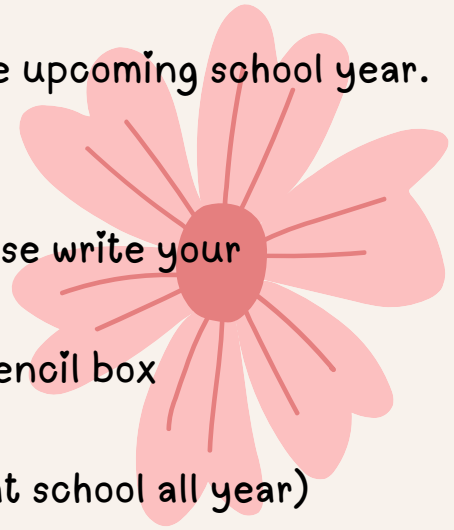

SUPPLY LIST

The following is a list of supplies your child will need for the upcoming school year.

- 1 1 inch binder with clear plastic view on the front
- 1 pencil box (approximately 8" X 5" and snaps shut, please write your child's name on outside)
- 1 box of Crayola Colored pencils (8 count)- placed in pencil box
- 1 pair of Fiskars Scissors -placed in pencil box
- 1 pair of over the head headphones (these will be kept at school all year)
- 1 box of skinny Crayola markers (10 pack)- placed in pencil box
- 3 plastic, pocket folders with the fasteners (one of each color) green, blue, and orange (plain-no designs.)
- 1 primary wide-ruled composition notebook- please write your child's name
- 1 large eraser- placed in pencil box
- 2 packages of thick, black, Expo Dry Erase Markers (packaging removed)- 2 markers placed in pencil box. Place the other markers in a Ziploc bag with your child's name.
- 1 personal pencil sharpener- placed in pencil box
- 1 package of 6 glue sticks - 1 placed in pencil box. Place the extra glue sticks in a ziploc bag with your child's name.
