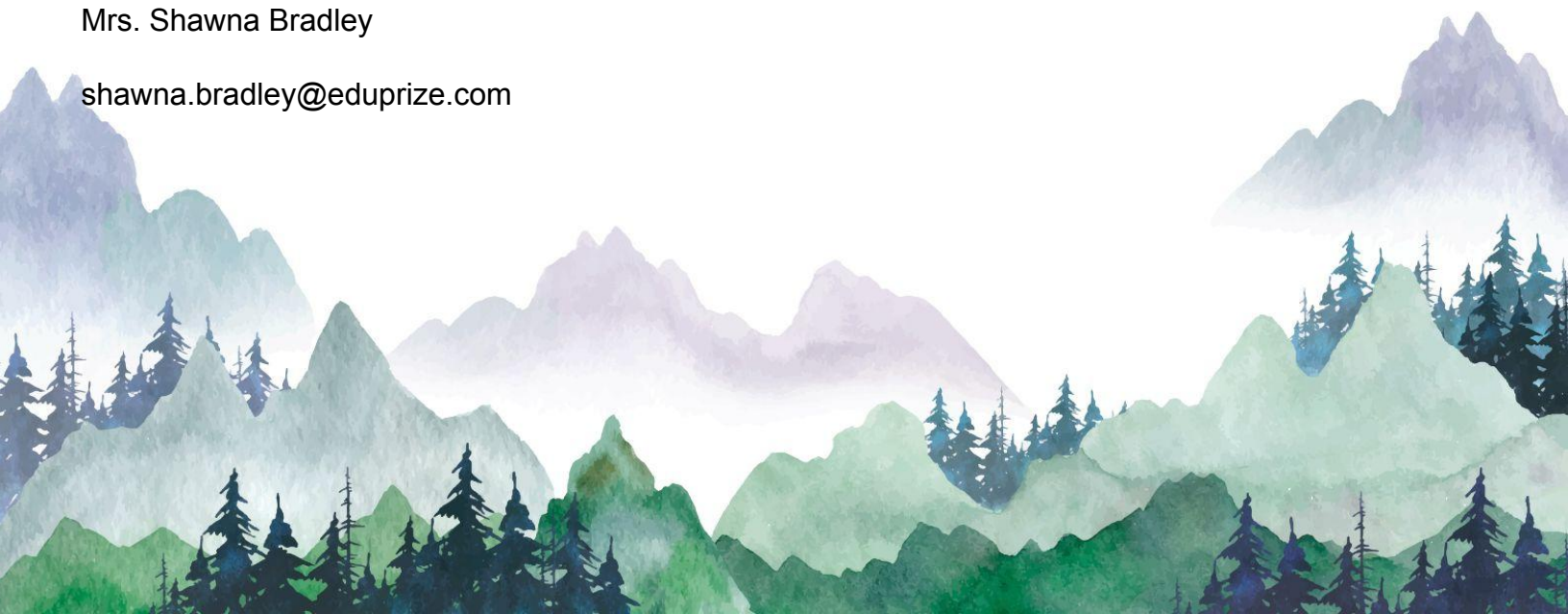

# Mrs. Bradley's Second Grade Suggested Supply List

## 2026-2027 School Year

**Please bring these supplies with you to the Open House.** If last year's supplies are still in good shape please reuse them for this year. Thank you for contributing to our classroom. **Please do not put your child's name on anything but the items requested.**

- (1) pencil box (**standard size, plastic**, do not buy the small narrow one) **Put your child's name on it**
- (1) pair of pointed scissors **Put your child's name on it and put in the pencil box.**
- (1) **1/2 inch**, 3 ring binder with inside pockets and a clear sleeve on the outside to hold a cover sheet. **Put your child's name on it**
- (6) glue sticks
- (2) boxes of **24** crayons **Put your child's name on them (put one in the pencil box)**
- (1) packages of Dixon Ticonderoga pencils (standard color, sharpened)
- (2) reams of white copy paper
- (2) packages of 4 low odor **fine-tip** dry erase markers
- (1) package of standard or heavy sheet protectors (Please no economy page protectors)
- (1) **yellow and red** wide ruled composition notebooks (**No names on them**)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 set of inexpensive headphones (Please of possible, no earbuds) **Put your child's name on them**
- 1 roll of paper towels

Daily: students need a backpack and a water bottle. Please make sure that their name is on both items. Make sure the backpack is big enough to fit their 3 ring binder in. **Please do not bring these to Open House.**
