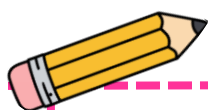


# Welcome to 2nd Grade AM Flex!

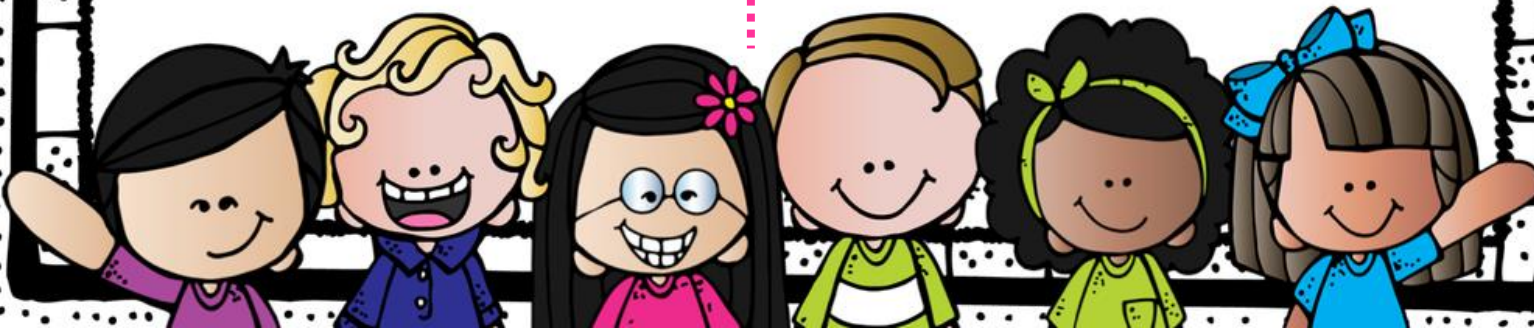

# EDUPRIZE 2nd Grade - Mrs. Burroughs 2026-2027 School Year

- 1 large-sized pencil box (Please write your child's name- Zip ones on Amazon work best)
- 1 pair of pointed scissors (Nothing fancy and please write your child's name)
- 1 heavy duty  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch three ring binder- white, with inside pockets and a clear sheet on the outside to hold a cover to be used as a Homework/Communication Book (Please write your child's name on the inside upper right-hand corner)
- 1 or 2 boxes of pencils Dixon Ticonderoga (sharpened if possible)
- 4 small glue sticks (we need lots of these, donations are appreciated)
- 2 white or pink pearl erasers
- 2 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
- Colored pencils or Twistables
- 1 pack of markers (fat or thin)
- 1 or 2 reams of white copy paper
- 1 hardcover composition notebook (Please write your child's name)
- 1 hardcover PRIMARY notebook (Please write your child's name)
- 1 package of thin, black dry erase markers
- 3 PLASTIC prong folder (1 Red, 1 yellow, 1 blue)
- 1 Crayola Watercolor pallet
- 1 pair of earbuds/headphones for the Chromebooks (these do not have to be new - each student will keep his/her own buds in their pencil box/tub)
- Computer mouse (optional)
- 4 Highlighters (Any color)
- Sharpies (thin or fat optional)
- 1 Hand Sanitizer (pump please)
- 1 roll of Paper Towels
