Supply List

 - 1 - pink eraser (put name on it)
 - 1 - pair of scissors (put name on it)
 - 1 - package of colored pencils or markers
 - [Highlighters](#): at least 3 different colors
 - 1 - set of headphones (not Bluetooth)
- Reusable water bottle - bring full every day AND Lunch Bag (include snack)
