When we start school, you will need to sign your child in and out every day in our attendance binder. For drop off and pick-up you will drive up to the building I playground in lane I. I will help your child in and out of the car, but they must either already be unbuckled, or be able to unbuckle themselves. Your child MUST bring a backpack with a spare change of clothes (clothes will be kept at school), a healthy snack, a water bottle clearly labeled with their name (straws GREATLY preferred), and wear closed-toed shoes daily. Please make sure their backpack is big enough to hold a standard sized folder and their lunchbox. I will provide your student with a take-home folder that they will bring to and from school everyday. This folder is a great way for us to communicate with each other and to keep all their work safe as it travels back home. I will also provide pencil boxes for all students to use.

I am absolutely thrilled to be a part of the EDUPRIZE family! I believe that learning happens best when students are out of their seats and using their hands to learn and explore the world around them. As well as teaching letters, sounds, shapes, and numbers, we will also explore storytelling, weather, planets, dinosaurs, and more!
