- plastic shoe box (or similar): big enough to hold supplies (label)- no taller than 3 ½ inches (lid not needed)
- 6 pocket folders with brads (red, yellow, blue, green, purple, orange)
- 2 spiral notebooks (70 page- not perforated)
- 1 pair of earbuds with wire (label)
