

WELCOME TO 6TH GRADE: ALDEKOHNA!

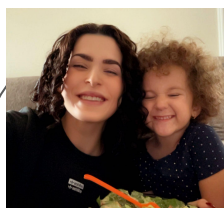
MISS ALDECOA (RM 82) & MRS. KOHN (RM 81)
