Onsite/Online (OSOL) — Grades 9–12

High school students (9th–12th grade) will have access to Onsite/Online (OSOL), a structured classroom space where students can come to complete their EO classwork.

Please note: OSOL is simply a physical location for students to complete their work. All high school coursework is still done online through the Subject platform, even when utilizing the OSOL space.

Students planning to attend OSOL are required to check in at the Building 3 front desk. While on campus, HS students will be required to remain in Room 301.
